HELL & BACK Junior - Terms & Conditions

For insurance reasons, all HELL & BACK Junior participants must have signed parental/guardian permission to take part in the event.

Age of Participants

Each child must be of the correct age to participate on the day. For H&B Junior 3KM (24/04/2022 & 21/05/2022), children must be aged 8+, while for H&B Junior 1KM (22/05/2022), children taking part must be aged 5+. Children younger than this will be unable to take part.

Physical Condition of Participants

Alive Outside recommends that any parent who has health-related concerns about their child taking part in H&B Junior should speak with a healthcare professional beforehand. Everyone taking part in H&B Junior does so at their own risk.

Insurance Cover when Participating in HELL & BACK Junior

As every participant has different insurance needs, it is the decision and responsibility of each parent/guardian to ensure their child is fully covered in accordance with their specific requirements when participating in H&B Junior. Alive Outside, the event organiser, strongly recommends that each participant has their own Personal Accident Cover in case of injury.

Infectious Diseases

Killruddery Estate is a large, vast working farm, which is home to a wide variety of plants and animals, both domestic and wild. As the course involves running through trenches and boggy ground, Alive Outside encourages all parents/guardians to be aware of the risks of Infectious Diseases, especially Weils / Leptospirosis Disease, which is an acute infectious disease spread by infected wild and domestic animals. In the unlikely event of your child developing any symptoms after the event, you should see a medical professional immediately.

By accepting these Terms & Conditions, you agree to the risks associated with running through the natural habitat of these plants and animals.
